FM English Basic 2023 =Academic Writing and Presentation=

Introduction:

This short introductory course aims to help non-native speakers of English to write academic papers effectively. The themes covered in the course include the writing process, elements of writing, language issues, vocabulary for writing, and writing models. Throughout the course, the participants are asked to do simple tasks in class or as homework to reinforce the topics discussed in class. Finally, the participants are asked to work on a short academic project of their choice and present it at the end of the course in a 5-minute presentation. Each participant is also asked to give an evaluation of one of the speeches presented in class.

The course gives the participants the opportunity to consider how to improve their academic writing and to apply those principles in presentations about research. Throughout the course, the participants are advised to investigate how the academic writing principles introduced in the class are applied in the articles in top journals in their fields. In order to promote innovation and collaboration, they are asked to communicate about the research in their field in a way that other scientists with different areas of expertise can understand it and be inspired by it.
